

Initial Costs for Cub Scouts

Uniform

Class A (standard) uniforms are available at the Council office—3039 Hanley Road, Central Point. Call 664-8477 to get their hours before heading over. You can also get them for about the same price at scoutstuff.org. Here's a list of what you'll need:

Short sleeve shirt (blue for 1 st -3 rd , tan for 4 th -5 th)	\$22.99 - \$34.99*
Crater Lake Council Shoulder Patch	\$3.15
Crater Lake Council Round Patch (Rt. Pocket)	\$1.50
World Scout Crest Emblem	\$1.49
Unit Numerals (112) Each 1.19	\$3.57
Den Numeral (wait to be assigned this #)	\$1.49
Neckerchief (color depends on rank)	\$5.99 - \$9.99
Neckerchief slide (depends on rank)	\$3.99
Total	\$44.17 - \$60.17

* Shirt cost depends on the material used; nylon is \$10 more than poplin

Handbook

Each rank has their own handbook that the boys work through to earn their badge.

Rank	Cost
Tiger- 1 st grade	\$5.99
Wolf- 2 nd grade	\$8.99
Bear- 3 rd grade	\$8.99
Webelos- 4 th /5 th grades	\$8.99

Handbooks are also available in coil-bound format costing about \$7 more.

Notes:

1. Costs are based on current 2009 Scout Shop handout updated 5/11/09.
2. We consider the following official apparel as optional accessories: hat, belt, pants, and socks. Typically boys wear blue jeans.
3. Get a size shirt big enough to last a few years. When boys transition to Boy Scouts they wear a tan uniform, hence it makes sense for 4th and 5th graders (Webelos) to purchase a tan uniform if starting out.
4. If you would rather heat transfer than sew patches, purchase *Badge Magic* for about \$8.00. It's specifically made to use for attaching the emblems to the uniform via heat transfer.
