

## Pack Volunteer Opportunities

The reason we are able to put on the events we do is because parents have stepped up and helped out. A few of us can't do this by ourselves. Please turn in this sheet with at least two areas in which you are willing to share your time, talent, and energy.

### Pack Events

*Rain gutter Regatta*—work to plan and put on the regatta. Organize race, assign jobs.

*Pinewood Derby*—work to organize the race, put track together, judge, photograph, etc.

*Rocket Launch*—help organize and run the bottle rocket launch activity.

*Blue & Gold Banquet*—plan, prepare, organize, cook, decorate, etc. for this annual event.

*Popcorn Kernel*—help track sales and distribution of popcorn during fall fund-raiser.

### Council Events

*Scouting for Food*—help with logistics in arranging distribution and pick up of bags.

*Snowcapades*—help with logistics in reserving date, signing up boys & families, collecting fees.

*Day Camp*—help promote and sign up boys and adult volunteers, collect fees & forms.

*Resident Camp*—reserve date, help promote and sign up boys and adults, collect fees & forms.

### Pack Organization [requires application]

*Den Leader, Co-Leader, Assistant*--Tiger (1<sup>st</sup>), Wolf (2<sup>nd</sup>), Bear (3<sup>rd</sup>), Webelos I (4<sup>th</sup>) & Webelos II (5<sup>th</sup>)

- Meet 1 to 2 times a month with boys in the den
- Use *Cub Scout Program Helps* as a planning guide
- Use the rank-specific handbook to organize activities
- Encourage boys to earn their Bobcat and badges of rank
- Help the den prepare a contribution to the pack meeting
- Attend pack meetings & pack outings with the den
- Provide immediate recognition to the boys

*Recruiter*—recruit new Cub Scouts by staffing a table [in uniform] for presentation in schools and other gatherings. Help with parent orientation in September.

*Trainer*—promote training of new leaders, attendance at roundtable, Pow Wows, and on-line completion of Youth Protection and rank-specific fast-track training.

*Committee Member*—participate in monthly planning meetings for events and pack meetings. Help set agendas, take and distribute minutes of meetings.
